#### School

## **Reminders and Updates**

<u>Toys, water bottles and communication books</u> – Until the pandemic is over, we are asking that parents <u>do not</u> bring in toys, water bottles or communication books. The children will be given specific cups to drink from and the information that would usually be included into the communication

books will be put onto Tapestry for you. Children under the age of 2years, can still bring bottles in if they cannot drink from a cup.

**Car Park/Parking/Public Transport** - Please be aware that parking is for drop off and collection only. Please do not leave cars here whilst going on the school run. Please also park considerately within the marked bays. **YOU MUST NOT PARK ON THE PAVEMENT.** If someone has parked on the pavement, they will be politely asked to move their car before they are able to drop off/collect their children. Ensure when getting out of your cars and when waiting outside the nursery, that you are social distancing. May we also ask parents to not use public transport unless there is no other option.

<u>Spare Clothing and Children's Belongings</u>— Please ensure you are bringing in spare clothes in a labelled bag such as a rucksack (not a plastic shopping bag). Please pass this to a member of the team when dropping your child at the entrance to the nursery. All spare clothing and belongings in the child's bag <u>must</u> be also be labelled. Even if you do not think your child needs spare clothing there will be occasions when they may need to be changed.

## Recipe of the month - Moussaka

- 500g minced beef
- · 1 tin of chopped tomato
- · 1 courgettes grated
- · 1aubergine chopped small
- $\cdot$  1 onions finely chopped
- · 1 tbsp tomato puree
- · 1 tbsp oil
- · 1 tbsp oregano
- 1 tbsp mixed herbs
- · 2 tbsp cornflour
- · 300ml soya/oat /cow milk
- · 200ml water

#### Mashed potato

- · 800g potato
- · 2 tbsp vitalite
- 50ml soya/oat/cow milk

- 1. Make the mashed potato by boiling the potatoes, then draining once cooked. Add the soya/oat/cow milk and vitalite and mash well.
- 2. Cook the minced beef in a pot over a medium heat. Add all ingredients except the cornflour and water. Mix well and cook for 30 minutes. Mix the cornflour and water in a jug, then add to the beef mixture. Cook for 10 minutes, and mix well.
- 3. Spread beef mixture in casserole trays and top with mashed potato.
- 4. Bake in the oven for 20 minutes at 180 degrees.
