# **Little Beans Celebrations Events & Special Days** in August 2022!


- 28th of July—8th of August—Commonwealth Games. The Commonwealth Games is an international multi-sport event involving athletes from the Commonwealth of Nations. In 2022 it will be held in Birmingham UK.
- 7th August—Sea Serpent Day! We will be exploring myths and stories about sea serpents and their incredible characteristics! Did you know the Kraken is believed to be a mile and a half long?
  - 8th August—International Cat Day! Organised by the International Fund for Animal Welfare, this is a day to think about your furry friend and appreciate everything you love about them.



- 10th August—Lion Day! Another day dedicated to our feline friends! Founded by Big Cat Rescue to highlight the importance of the lion globally and to raise lion conservation awareness worldwide.
- 12th August—Elephant Day! A day dedicated to the world's largest land animal, we will be exploring where they live, what they like to do and all sorts of fun facts about them to raise awareness of these fantastic endangered beasts!
- 19th August—International Orangutan Day! We will be learning about these beautiful brightly coloured creatures and how their habitat is so precious and what we can do to help!
- 24th August—International Dog Day! A day to celebrate man's best friend! We will be looking at the characteristics of dogs and how they vary so much from breed to breed!



28th August-International Bat Night! We will be learning about bats and how they stay awake at night-time!



Your new born baby can already distinguish the unique rhythmic patterns of the language they heard you speaking in the months before their birth.

By the time your baby has started babbling sounds, they have already started learning abstract language patterns and creating abstract language rules.

Language learning increases your baby's attention to nearby objects. This cognitive attention-boosting by language is found in babies as young as 3 months.

When your baby is babbling, they are experimenting. Babies babble both speech sounds and non-speech sounds and their brains learn to filter out which sounds do not belong to the language they are learning. For example, some babies may practice raspberries during babbling until they learn the sound is not part of the target language.

By the time your baby says their first words, they are already able to understand a large number of words of their language, even if they aren't able to say them all yet.

# Recipe of the Month:

**Turkey Bolognaise** 

# **Ingredients**

800g minced turkey 250g green lentils 2 cartons tomato passata 1 tin chopped tomatoes 250g grated carrots 2 grated courgettes 2tbsp grounded garlic 2tbsp mixed herbs 2 vegetable stock cubes 1 packet of spaghetti



# Method:

- 1. Boil the minced turkey and lentils in a pot of water for 30 mins.
- 2. Meanwhile grate or finally chop the courgettes and carrots and place them into the minced turkey and lentil mixture for the last 10 mins
- 3. Once cooked add the tomato passata, herbs, garlic and the chopped tomatoes together and simmer for 20 mins
- 4. Place the spaghetti into a pot of boiling water and boil for 20 mins until cooked.
  - 5. Serve and enjoy!!

# Top Tip:

If you would like to make meal times more fun, once the spaghetti is cooked mix some food colouring in it and leave for 5 mins to soak up. You will get fun colourful spaghetti! If your child prefers pasta then you can do the same with pasta instead of spaghetti.
